SAME-SEX COUPLES: THE BAN ON ACCESSING ASSISTED PROCREATION PROCEDURES IS NOT UNCONSTITUTIONAL

Today, the Constitutional Court sat in chambers to discuss the questions raised by the Ordinary Courts of Pordenone and Bolzano on the constitutionality of Law no. 40 of 2004, insofar as it bans same-sex couples from accessing procedures for medically assisted procreation.

Pending filing of the judgment, the Press Office informs the public that at the end of the session, the questions were declared unfounded.

The Court established that the challenged provisions do not conflict with the constitutional principles invoked by the two courts.
