EXTRAORDINARY SESSION AND MEETING WITH THE PRESS

On 13 May, an extraordinary session of the Constitutional Court will be held at 11:00 a.m. in the Salone Belvedere of *Palazzo della Consulta*. During this session, which will be attended by the Head of State and the four other holders of the highest offices of State, President Giancarlo Coraggio will deliver a speech on general issues arising in the Constitutional Court's case law in 2020.

Afterwards, as is customary, President Coraggio will meet with journalists in order to answer their questions.

The event will be broadcast live by TG2 on RAI 2 from 11:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon, and repeated later on RaiNews24.

The *Palazzo della Consulta* may be accessed via the central porters' lobby in Piazza del Quirinale between 9.45 and 10.30 a.m.

In order to enable attendees to participate safely in the light of the health emergency, the press conference may be attended **either in person or remotely via Microsoft Teams**.

In both cases, interested journalists must obtain accreditation by **sending an email no later than 12.00 noon on TUESDAY 11 MAY to ufficio.stampa@cortecostituzionale.it**, stating their **full name, email address, press card number and publication.**

Each journalist must indicate whether he or she intends to attend in person or remotely. If attending in person, in order to ensure compliance with physical distancing requirements, **entry will be limited to 20 people (on a first-come, first-served basis in order of accreditation)**; in addition, journalists and media staff must present a negative test result for a **rapid antigen swab test taken within the previous 48 hours.** If attending remotely, journalists will be sent an email with details of how to access Teams.

In view of the circumstances, you are strongly invited to **respect the rules for accreditation** in order to enable the Court to organise the meeting with the press in the best possible manner, and to ensure that all those with an interest have the opportunity to attend.
